3.1	Indicator Framework for the Surveillance of Chronic Disease, PHAC Popy reviewed the background information on the project that was circulated previously (Marisol Belancourt who was unable to attend). There are 325 indicators in five domains in the framework, and the next deliverable for the project is an annual report.  The following questions were raised by CIWG: who is the audience; are the indicators health care or public health focused; is there overlap with the national indicators from Statistics Canada.	Popy will take the questions back to Marisol.  The consultation with CIWG will be through Brenda or Shanna (when she returns).
3.2	Popy asked if the project team should consult with CIWG.  MOHLTC's GIS Strategy & proposed partnership with CIWG – Kevin Yam and Elsa Ho Kevin summarized the MOHLTC's GIS strategy – they are currently 6 months into the 3-year plan. Elsa provided examples of indicator mapping by PHU from CCHS survey (smoking, physical activity, overweight).  Mary-Anne suggested that CIWG explore having links to maps on the website for any core indicators for which they're available.
